CONFERENCE LODGING

Participants must make their own lodging arrangements. A block of rooms has been reserved at the Hyatt Regency New Orleans. The special group rate is \$185 per night for single/double occupancy (\$25 for each additional person beyond two), plus applicable taxes and fees.

NASDME has negotiated free high-speed internet access in the sleeping rooms and public lobby areas, as well as complimentary usage of the health club.

The cutoff date for reservations at the group rate is Tuesday, April 9, 2019 or when the block is filled, whichever comes first. Please call Reservations at 888-591-1234 and reference the code **NASD**. You may also book your room online through a link on the NASDME website at **www.nasdme.org**.

If you must cancel your reservation, please note you must cancel by 4:00 pm CST **72 hours** prior to arrival. If you cancel fewer than three (3) days prior to your arrival, your credit/debit card will be charged one night's room and tax.

PARKING

Self-parking is not available at the hotel. Valet parking is available for \$40 per night plus tax and includes in and out privileges. There is a parking garage adjacent to the hotel on 1301 Girod Street that is \$25 per day; however, it does not have in and out privileges. There are also other parking lots and garages in the area.

AIR TRAVEL

New Orleans is accessible through the Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport (MSY). The airport is located a short distance (approximately 15 miles) from the Hyatt Regency New Orleans. GROUND TRANSPORTATION

Airport Shuttle

Airport Shuttle New Orleans is offering discounted airport transportation. The discounted rate is \$40 per person for round trip and \$20 per person for one way. The first stop from the airport is the Hyatt Regency New Orleans and the hotel is the last pickup stop before going to the airport. Official airport/hotel shared ride shuttle reservations must be made **online** at least 24 hours prior to your flight arrival time. The link to make shuttle reservations can be found at **www.nasdme.org**.

Taxi, Uber, and Lyft

Taxi booths are located on the first level of the Terminal outside of Baggage Claim Belts 1 and 14. Passengers must wait in line at one of these booths for taxi service. Taxi rides cost approximately

\$36 from the airport to the Central Business District (CBD) for up to two (2) passengers. For three (3) or more passengers, the fare will be approximately \$15 per passenger. Taxis are required to accept credit card payments.

Uber and Lyft offers transportation services from the Airport. Passengers can meet their app-based ride service in the Ground Transportation Center lot located on the first floor of the Short-Term Parking Garage by crossing the pedestrian crosswalk located outside of Baggage Claim 6. The cost of Uber and Lyft is approximately \$35.
